FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q1 - What Political Science courses are eligible for me to take abroad?

A1. In order for study abroad courses to be allowable for the major, they must be Political Science courses, and transfer to UCSD as upper-division, with 4 or units each, and with a letter grade of C- or better.

Q2 - How many courses can I transfer into the major?

A2. Political Science majors may transfer up to six courses from outside UCSD to the major; Political Science minors may transfer in up to two courses from outside UCSD to the minor. These courses include those from EAP/OAP courses, community college courses, courses taken at other 4-year universities, and AP courses.

Q3 - When should I start planning my study abroad experience?

A3. As early as possible! Ideally, students should start planning 10 - 14 months in advance of when they hope to study abroad for the most seamless experience.
